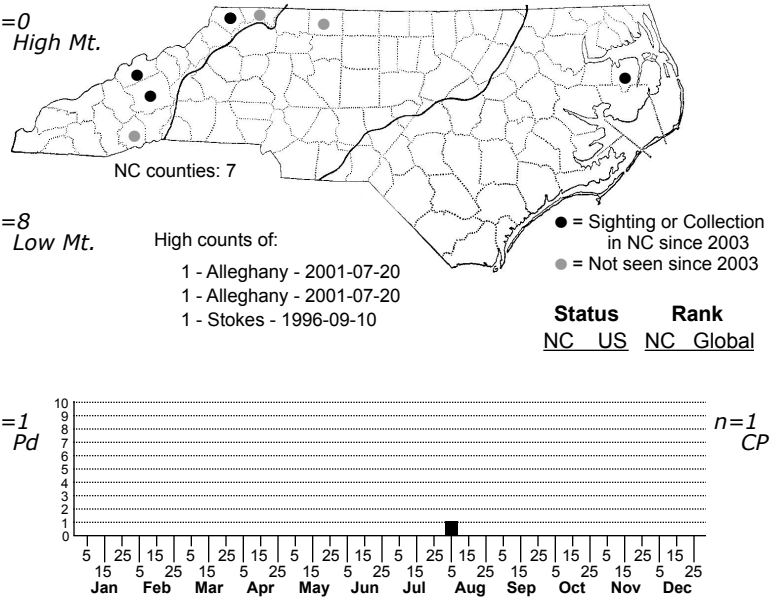
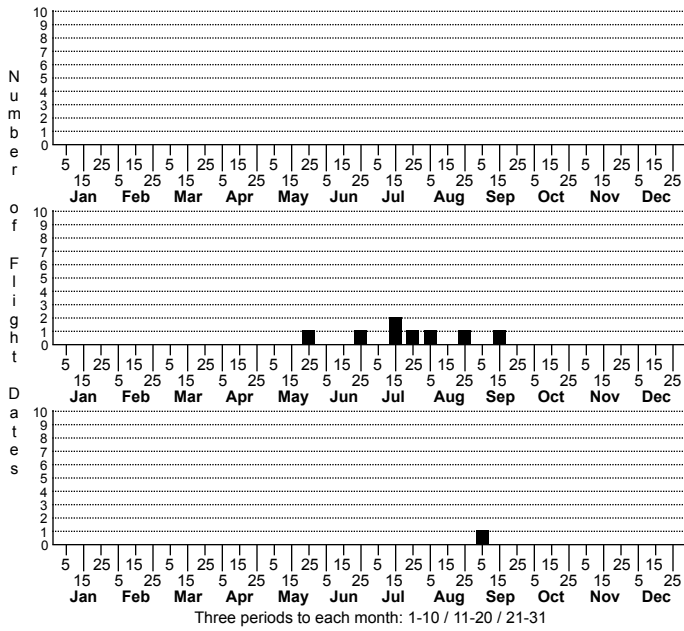


*Timandra amaturaria* Cross-lined Wave Moth
