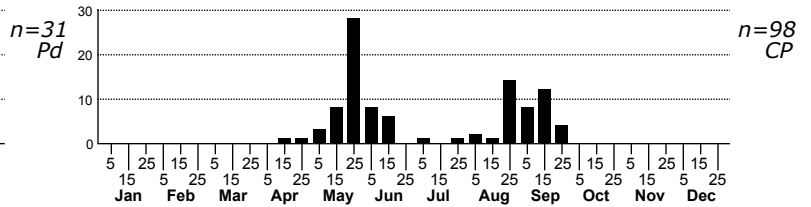
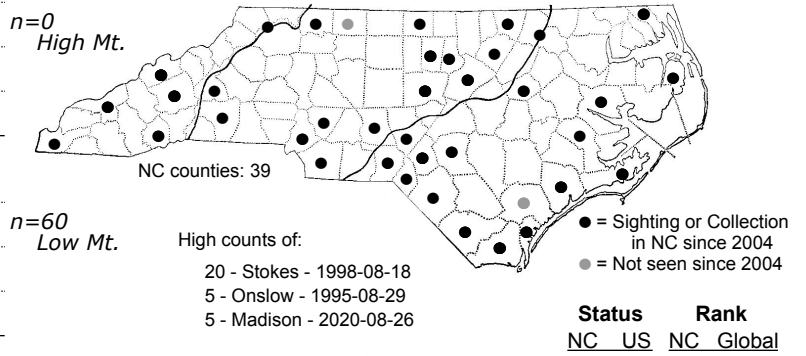
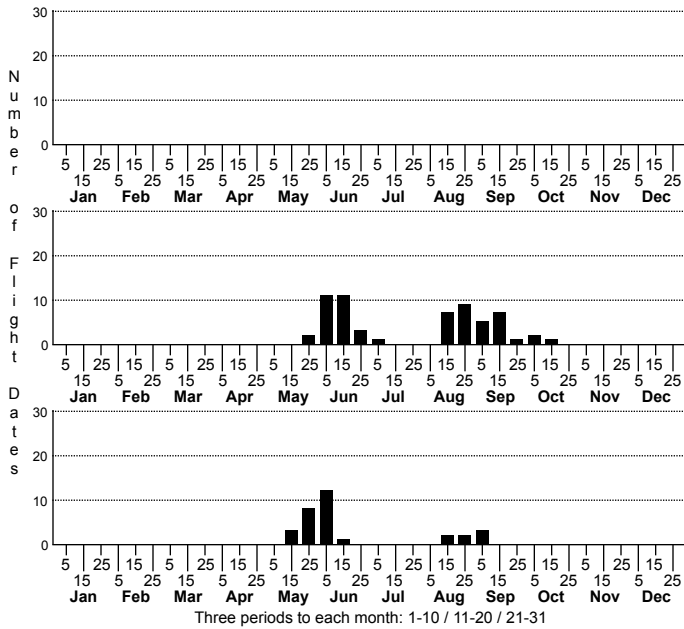


Lophosis labeculata Stained Lophosis Moth
