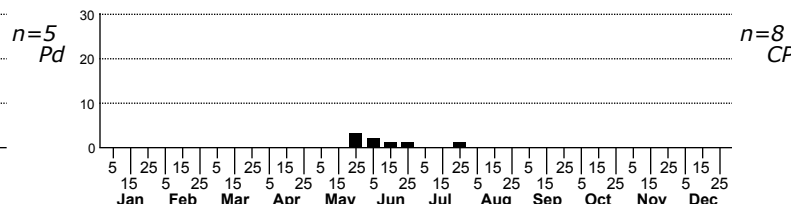
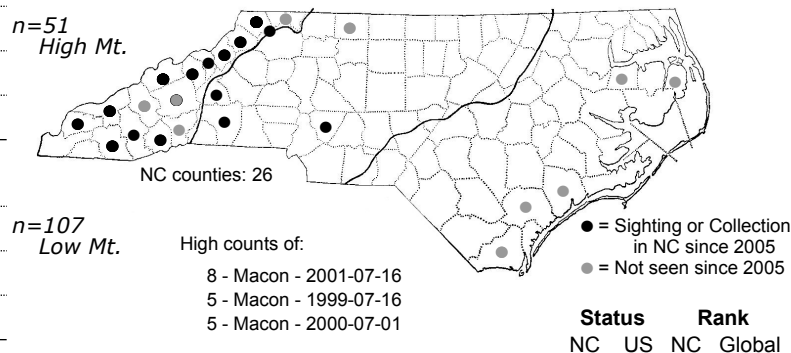
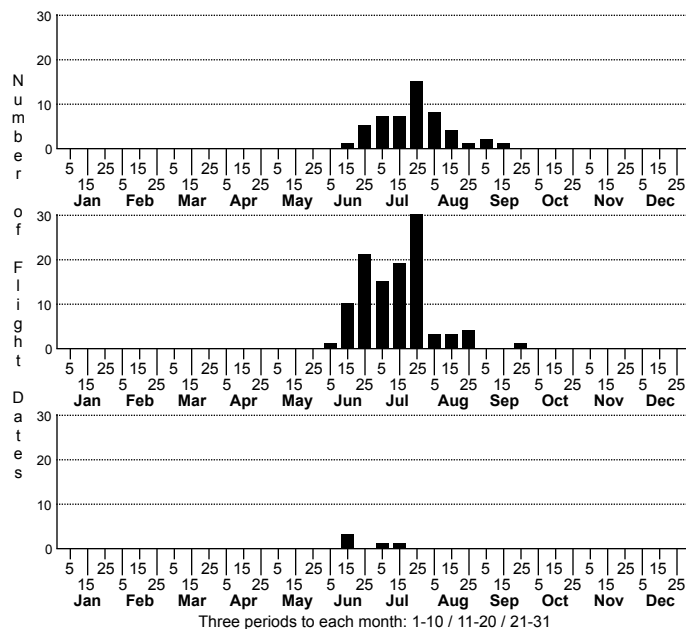


Gandaritis atricolorata Dark-banded Geometer

HABITAT: Woodlands and forests (Wagner et al., 2001). Our records come from wet-mesic hardwood forests in the Coastal Plain, the habitat of *Hydrangea barbara*. In the Mountains, records come from cove forests, riparian forests, and high elevation forests, including northern hardwood and spruce-fir communities. Habitats used in the Piedmont are less certain.

FOOD: Larvae reportedly feed on *Hydrangea* species (Wagner et al., 2001). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.
