

HABITAT: Our records from the Coastal Plain come almost entirely from wet forests, including non-riverine swamp forests. Piedmont records also include riparian forests. Mountain records come from riparian forests and cove forests.

FOOD: The larvae appear to feed primarily on <i>Impatiens</i> (Dyar, cited by Forbes, 1948). Covell (1984) additionally lists birch, blackberry, hawthorn, and willow. As of 2024, we have one rearing record for Spotted Jewelweed (<i>I. capensis</i>).
