
Hydrelia inornata Unadorned Carpet

HABITAT: Most of our records come from montane hardwood forests. One record comes from a relatively high mondanock in the western Piedmont. Habitats are mostly unrecorded.

FOOD: Larvae feed primarily on birches (<i>Betula</i>), but have also been recorded on hop-hornbeam (<i>Ostrya</i>) (Wagner, 2005).
