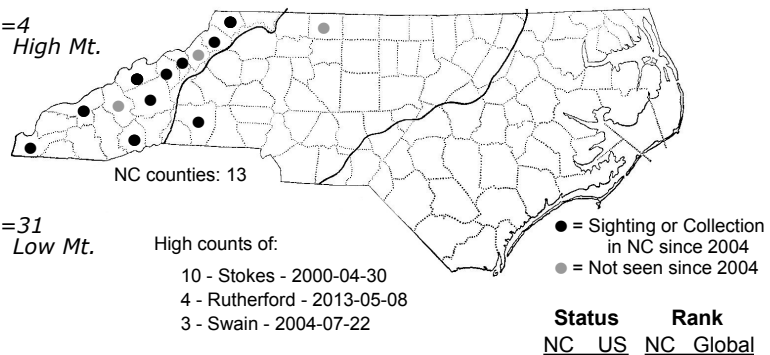
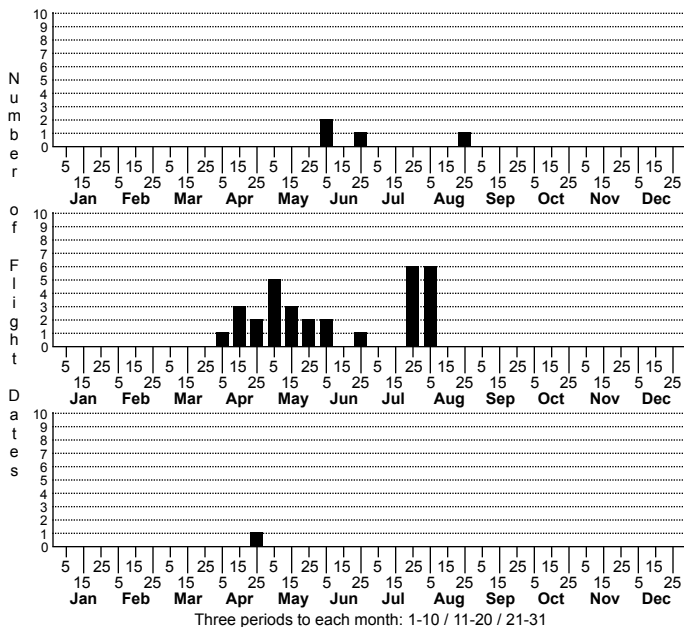


*Eupithecia palpata* Small Pine Looper
