



ID COMMENTS: The ground color of the forewings is a soft even gray, crossed by multiple lines (Taylor, 1906). A very minute discal dot is present but most markings are obscure. According to MacDunnough (1949), there is a tendency for the median area to be somewhat darker, followed by a narrower pale band.
