




Eupithecia lariciata Larch Pug Moth

HABITAT: Our one record comes from a site with both cove and alluvial forest.

FOOD: Larvae feed on fir (<i>Abies</i>), Eastern Hemlock (<i>Tsuga canadensis</i>), larch (<i>Larix</i>), spruce (<i>Picea</i>), and rarely other conifers (Maier et al., 2011). We do not have any feeding records in North Carolina.
