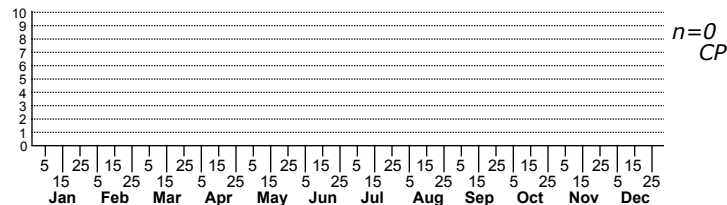
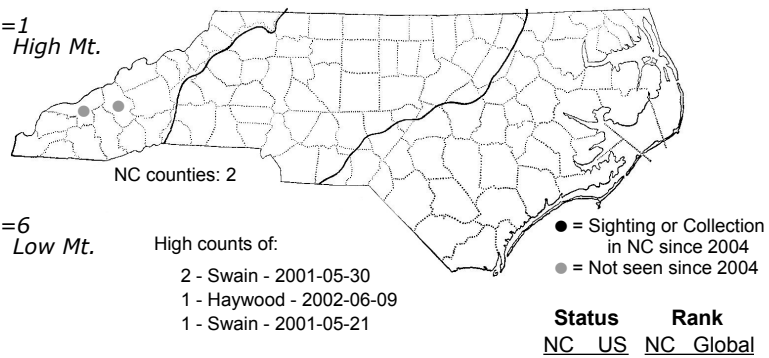
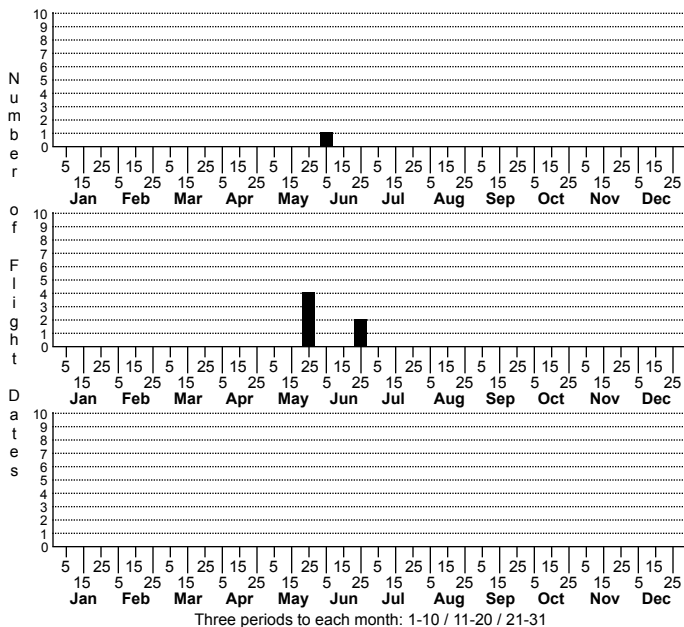


Eupithecia mutata Spruce Cone Looper Moth
