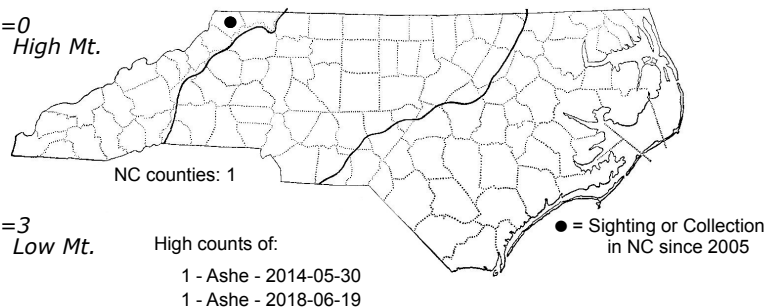
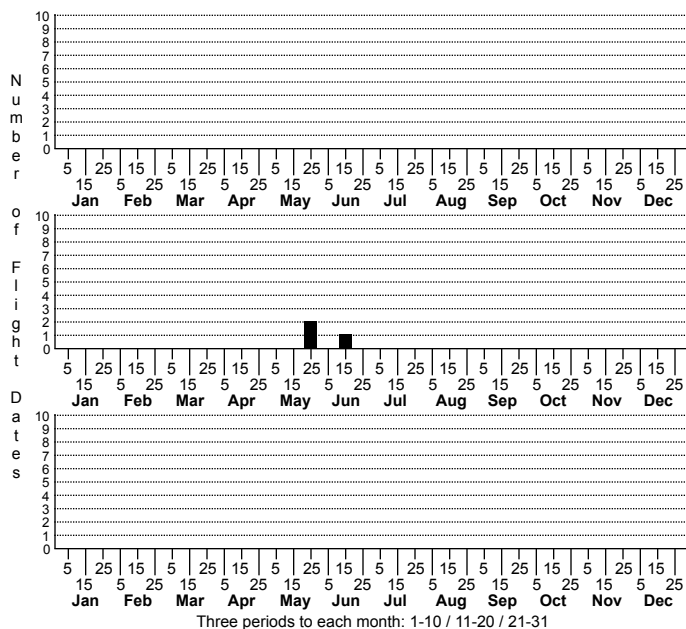
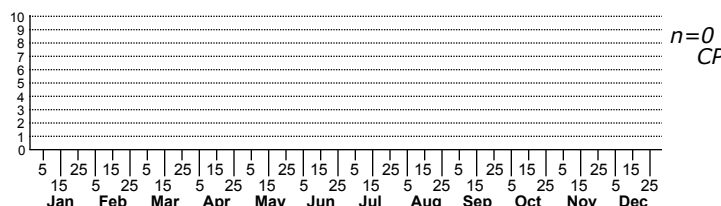


Lobophora nivigerata Powdered Bigwing Moth

HABITAT: Our one record for this species comes from an upland site that lacks *Populus* but is located uphill from a branch of the New River where Poplars have been observed.

FOOD: Larvae feed mainly on poplar (*Populus*) but also on willow (*Salix*) to a lesser extent (Wagner et al., 2001).
