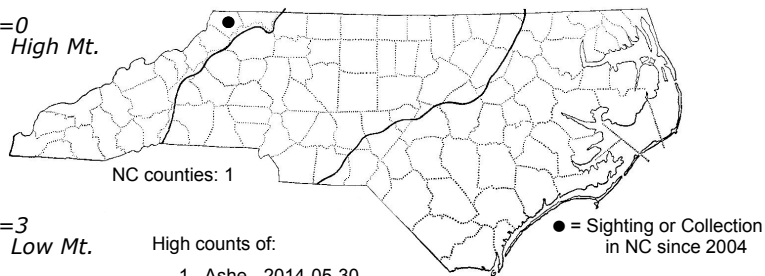
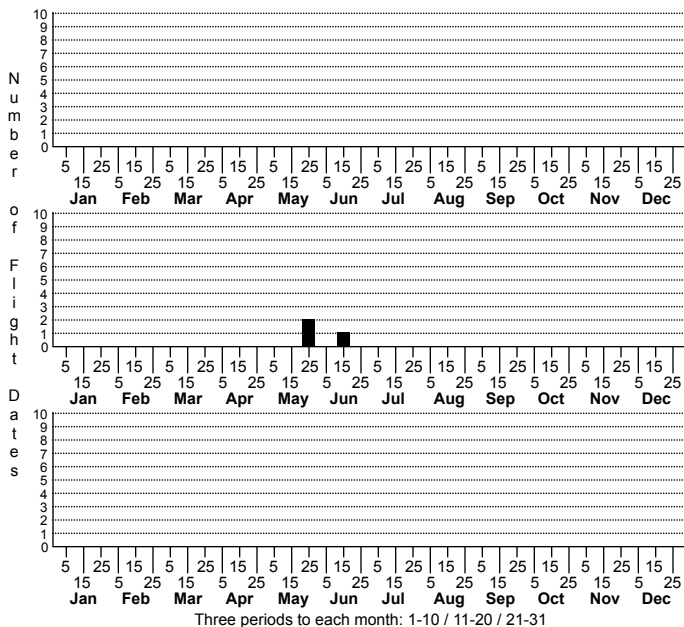
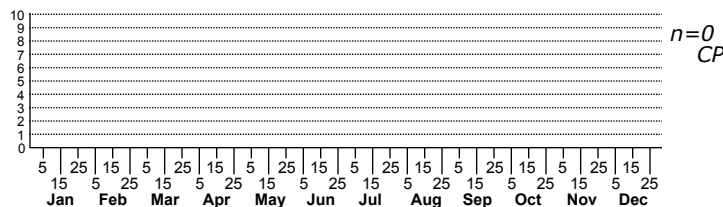


Lobophora nivigerata Powdered Bigwing Moth

HABITAT: Our one record for this species comes from an upland site that lacks Populus but is located uphill from a branch of the New River where Poplars have been observed

FOOD: Larvae feed mainly on Poplar but also on Willow to a lesser extent (Wagner et al., 2001)
