



Notodonta scitipennis Finned-willow Prominent

HABITAT: Records from Alleghany County come from a site located next to a small river. We also have an historic record from Brevard (Wray, 1967), which is located along the French Broad River, although we do not know of any records for *Populus* from Transylvania county.

FOOD: Reported hosts include poplars (*Populus*) and willow (*Salix*) (Ferguson, 1975; Miller et al., 2018).

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.
