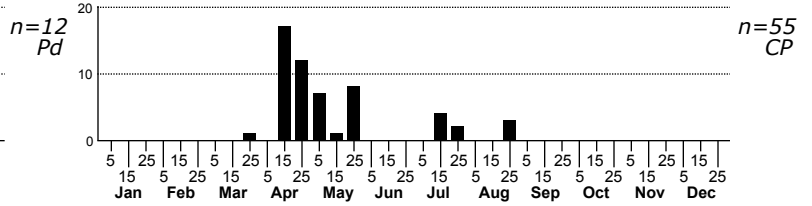
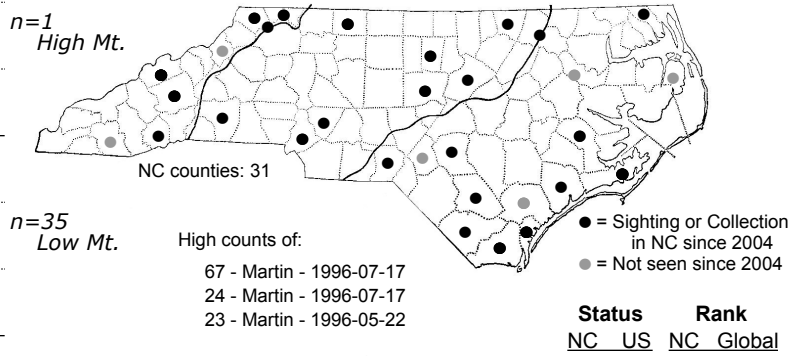
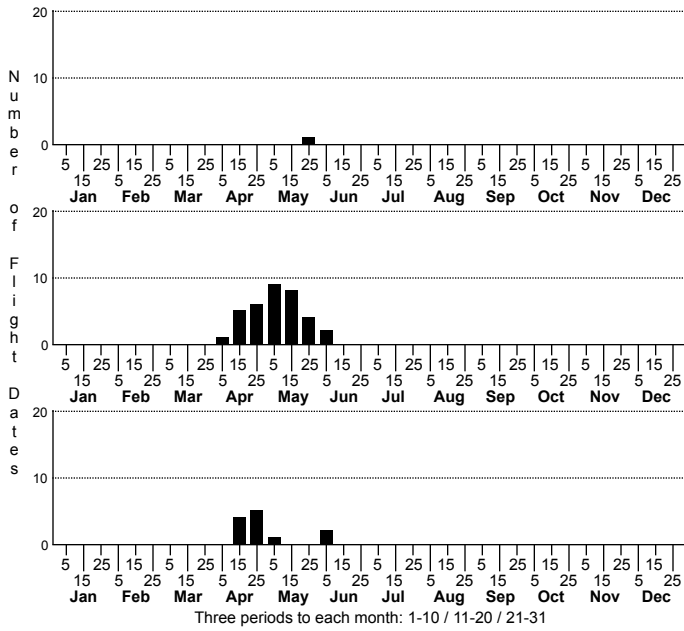

HABITAT: Found across the range of Nyssa species, from deep swamps and blackwater alluvial forests in the Coastal Plain to dry ridges in the Piedmont and Mountains

FOOD: Stenophagous, feeding on species of Black Gum (Nyssa spp.) (Wagner et al., 2011)
