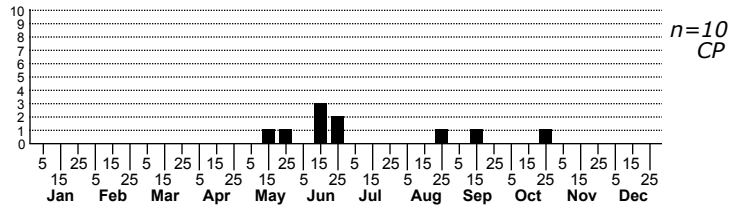
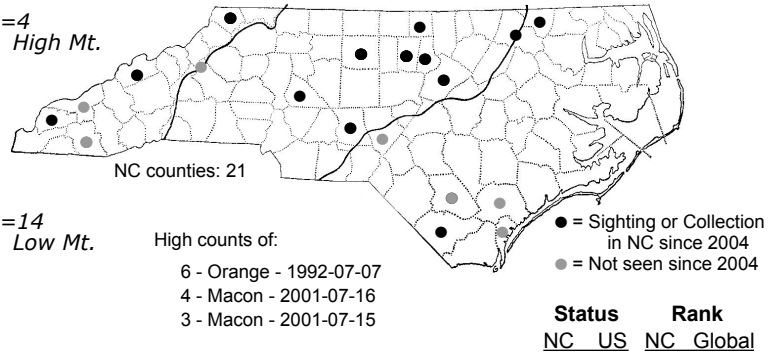
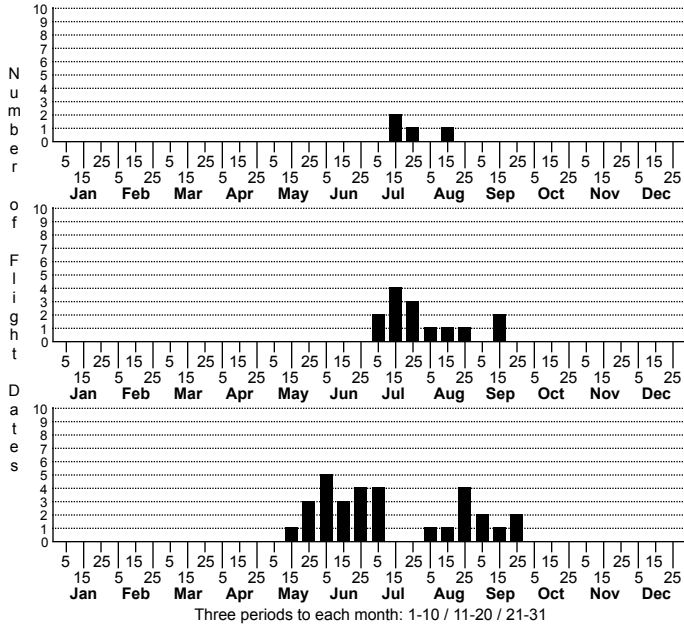


Renia flavipunctalis Yellow-spotted Renia Moth
