



ID COMMENTS: "In *Sigela rosea*, the forewing is roughly similar to that of *S. basipunctaria* except that there are submarginal splotches of dark gray and black scales, and the costa is gray (rather than pink), with larger black spots than those of *S. basipunctaria*" (Troubridge, 2020).
