
## Hypena edictalis Large Snout

## ID COMMENTS:

DISTRIBUTION: The species has not been recorded outside the Mountains in North Carolina.

FOOD: Larvae reportedly feed on wood-nettle (<i>Laportea</i>) and possibly Stinging Nettle (<i>Urtica</i>) (Wagner et al., 2011).
