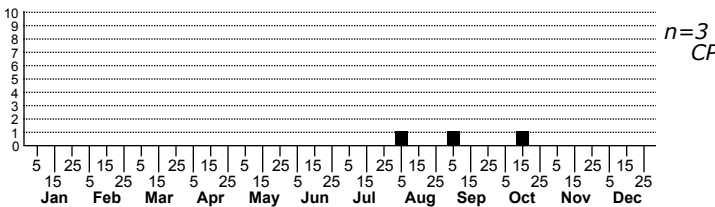
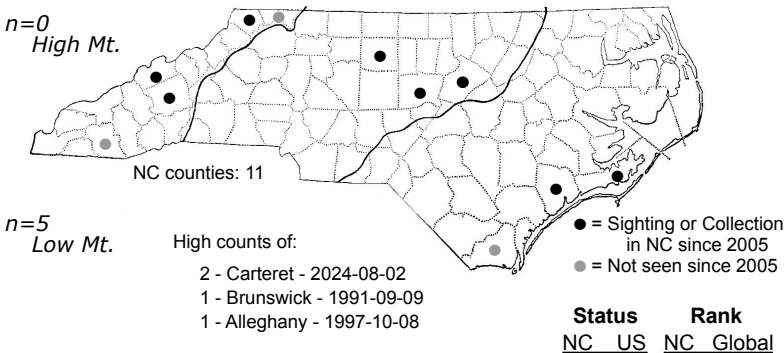
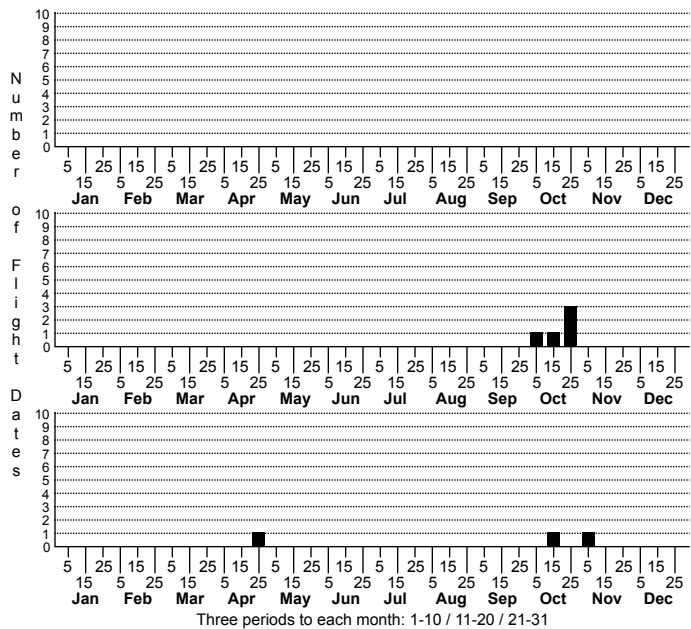


*Hypena minualis* Sooty Snout
