HABITAT: Our records come from old fields and other open habitats where Dogbane is common.

FOOD: The larvae feed on dogbane ( $\langle i \rangle$ Apocynum $\langle i \rangle$  spp.) (Wagner et al., 2011). The known hosts include Spreading Dogbane ( $\langle i \rangle$ A. androsaemifolium $\langle i \rangle$ ) and Hemp Dogbane ( $\langle i \rangle$ A. cannabinum $\langle i \rangle$ ). As of 2024, we have one feeding record for Hemp Dogbane.
