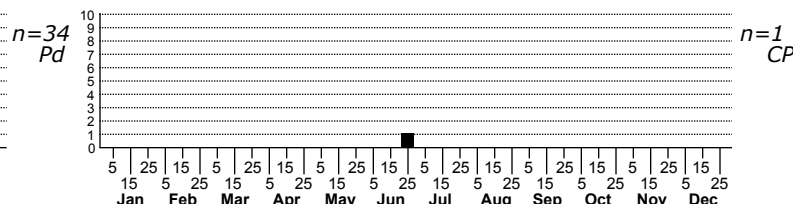
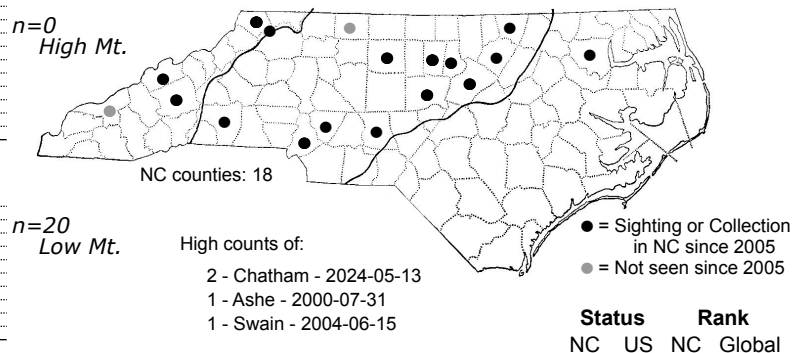
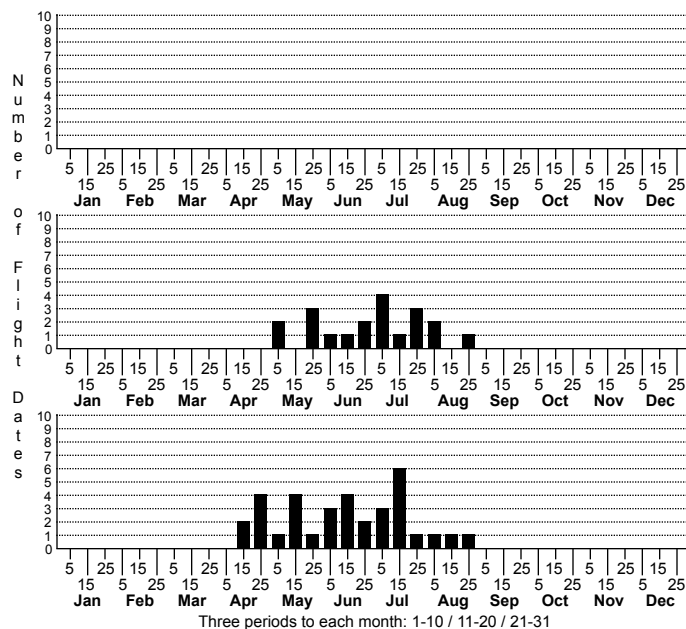


Spargaloma sexpunctata Six-spotted Gray

HABITAT: Our records come from old fields and other open habitats where Dogbane is common.

FOOD: The larvae feed on dogbane (<i>Apocynum</i> spp.) (Wagner et al., 2011). The known hosts include Spreading Dogbane (<i>A. androsaemifolium</i>) and Hemp Dogbane (<i>A. cannabinum</i>). As of 2024, we have one feeding record for Hemp Dogbane.
