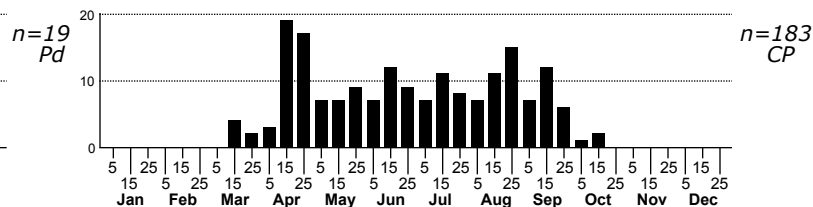
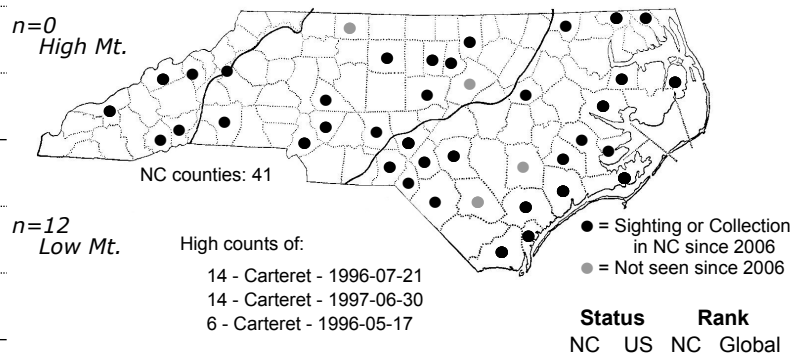
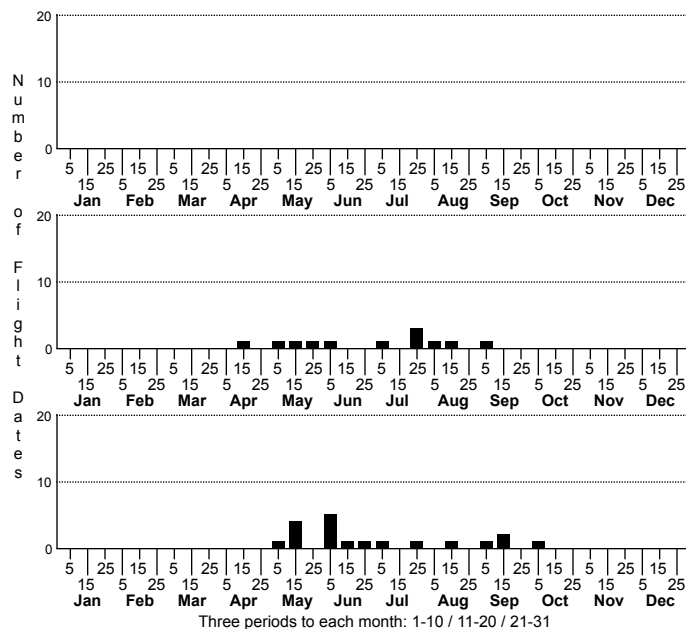


# Phyprosopus callitrichoides Curve-lined Owllet Moth
