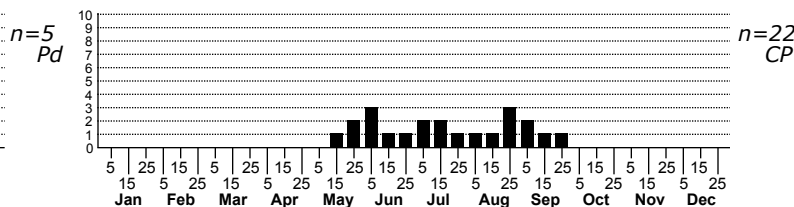
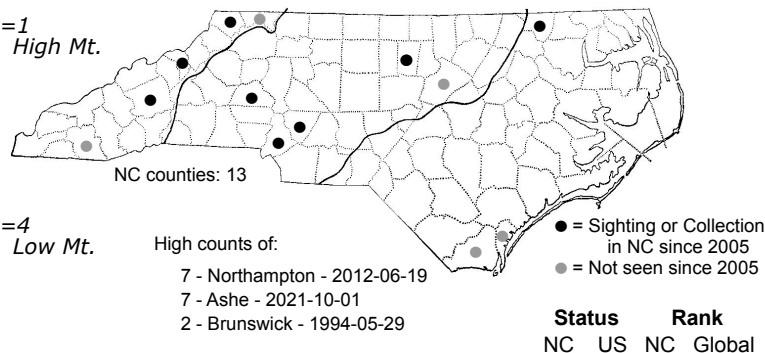
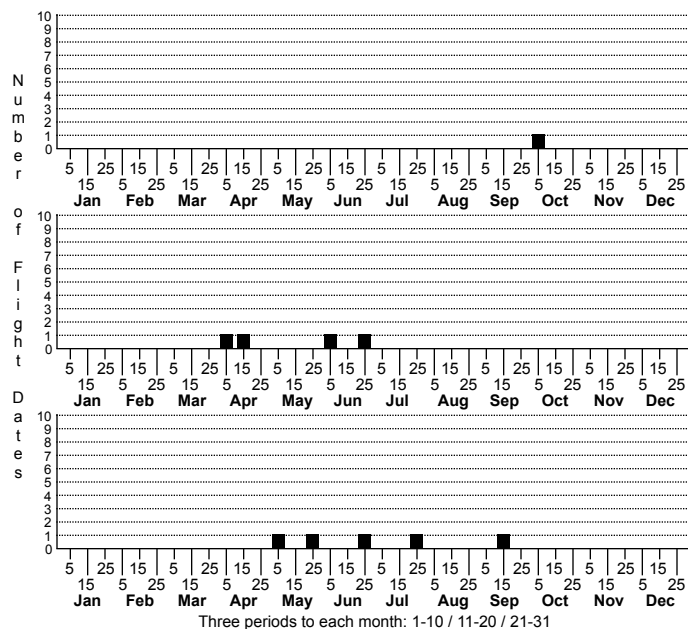


Scoliopteryx libatrix Herald Moth

HABITAT: Our records come almost entirely from sites where willow-containing wetlands are present.

FOOD: Larvae feed mainly on willows (*Salix*), but also on poplars (*Populus*) and birches (*Betula*) to some extent (Wagner et al., 2011).
