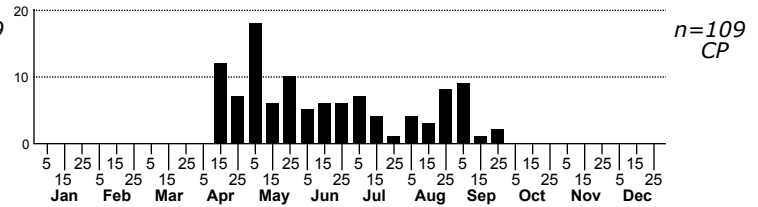
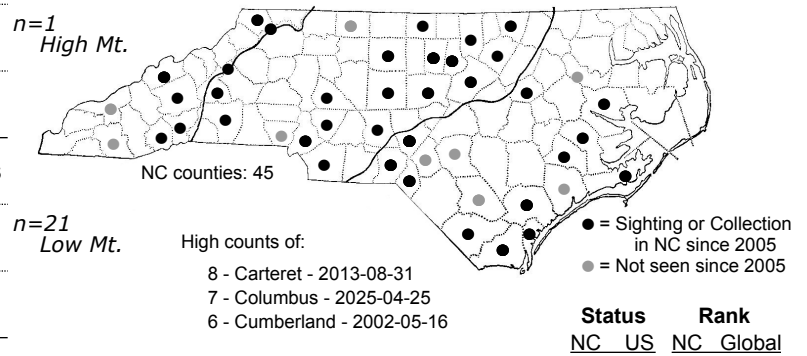
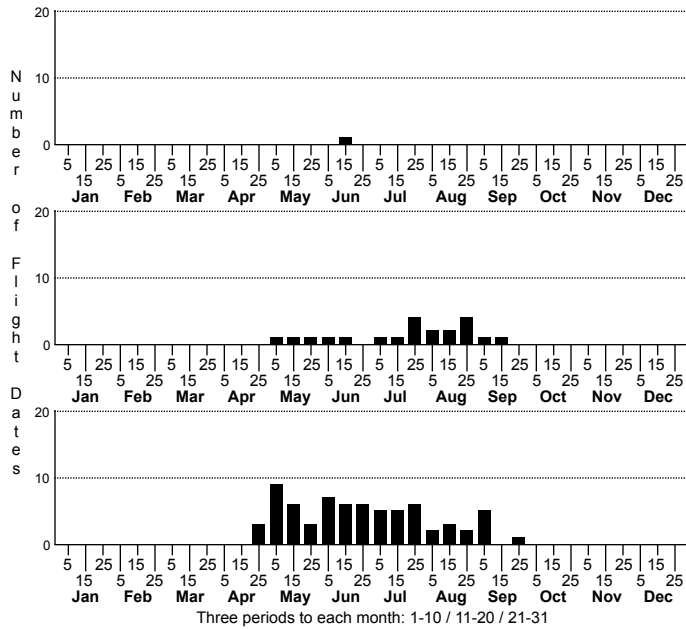


Lesmone detrahens Detracted Owllet Moth
