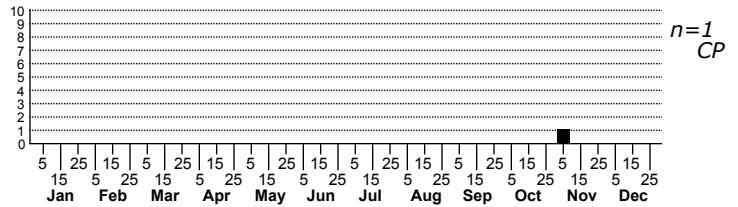
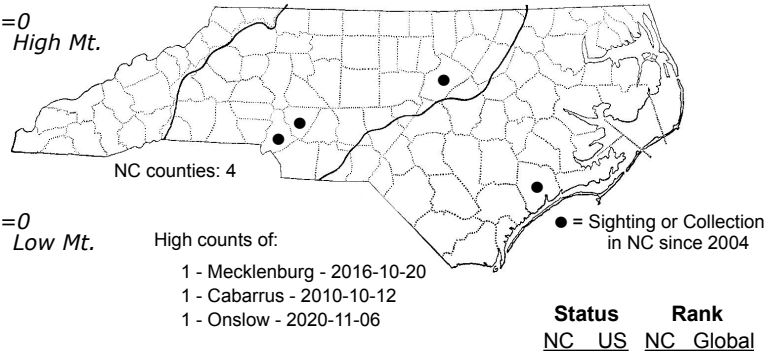
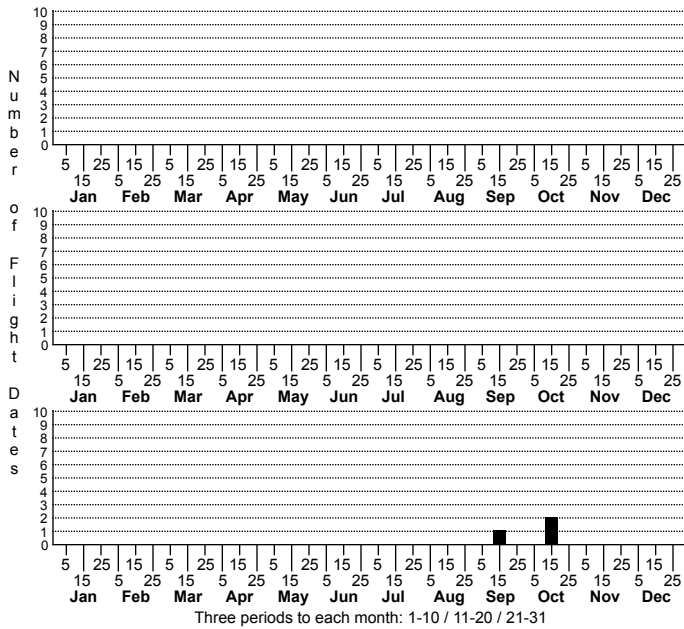


Selenisa sueroides Pale-edged Selenisa Moth

FOOD: Larvae feed primarily on species in the Leguminosae, including Partridge-Pea and Robinia; other recorded hosts include grasses and spurge (Robinson et al., 2010)
