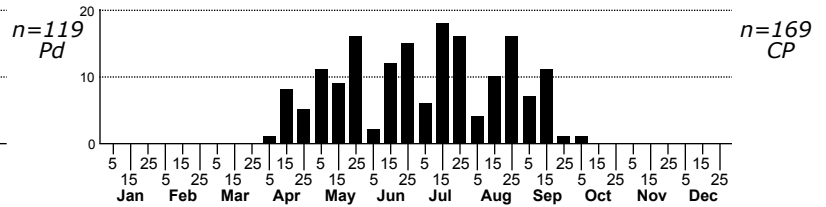
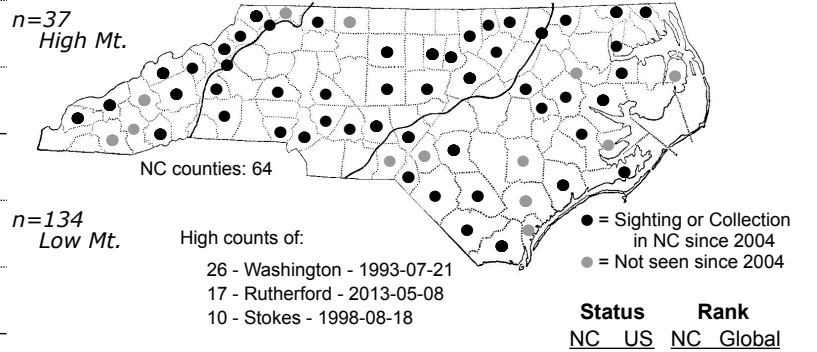
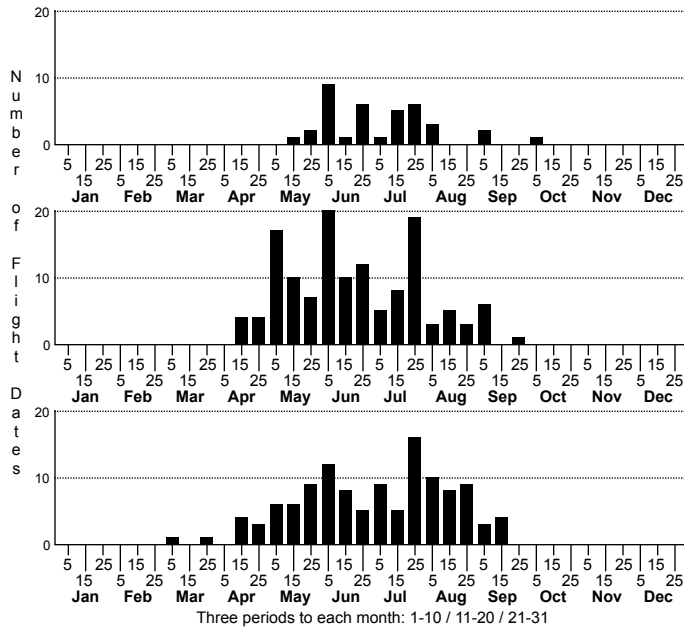


Parallelia bistriaris Maple Looper
