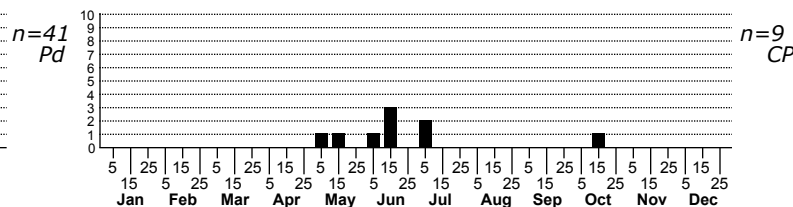
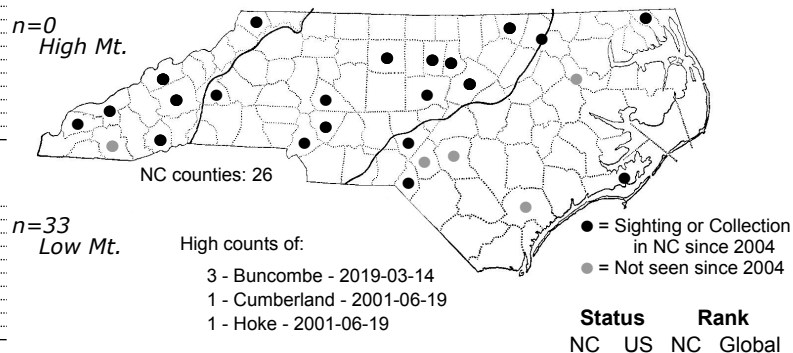
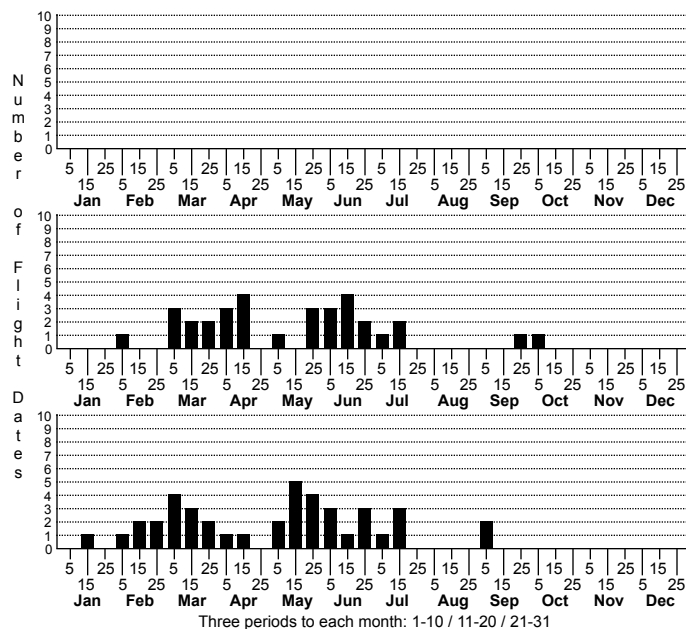

HABITAT: We have a few records from habitats where Balsam Poplar occurs, but the majority come from shoreline habitats where willows are the likely host plants

FOOD: Larvae feed on Bigtooth Aspen, Balsam Poplar, and various willows (Wagner et al., 2011)
