


HABITAT: We have records both from basic forests and glades, where basiphilic species of *Ruellia* occur, as well as from mesic sandhill habitats, where other species of *Ruellia* are found

FOOD: Larvae feed on the seedheads of wild-petunias (*Ruellia* spp.) (Wagner et al., 2011).
