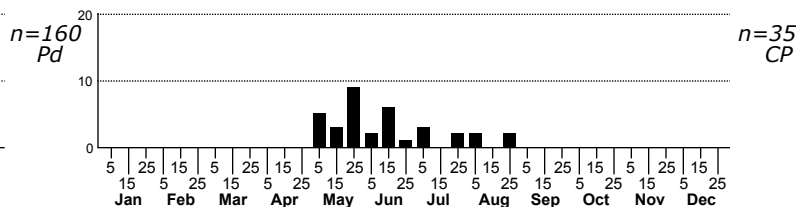
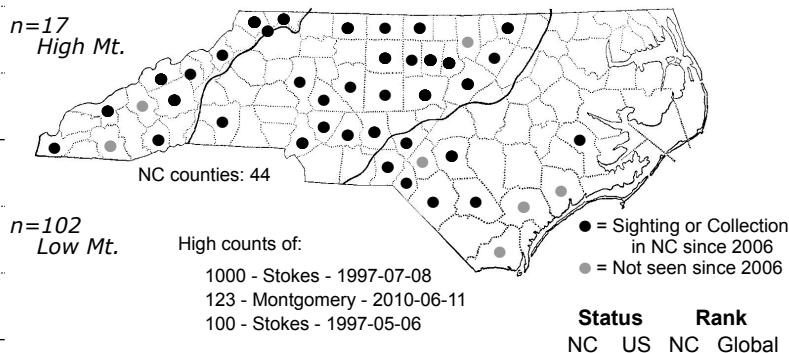
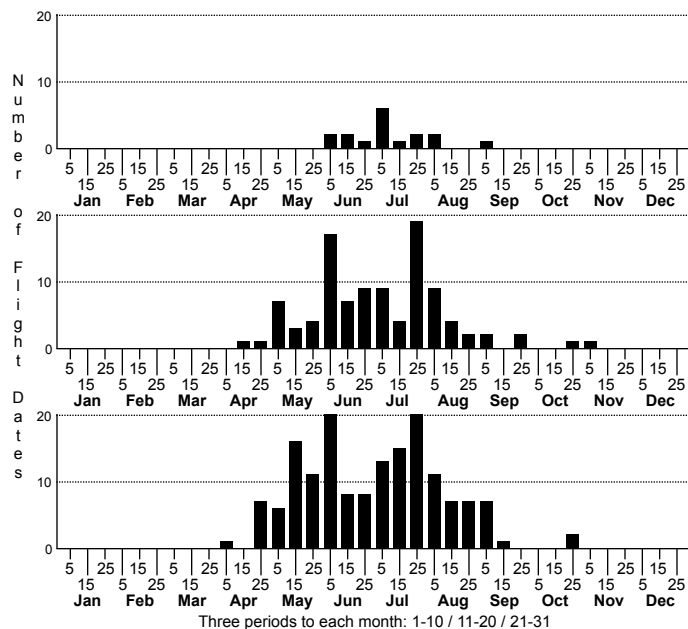


Hyperstrotia nana White-lined Graylet
