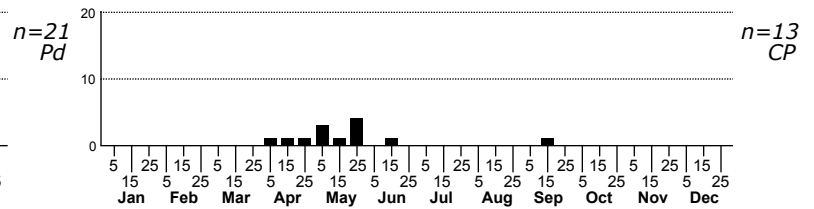
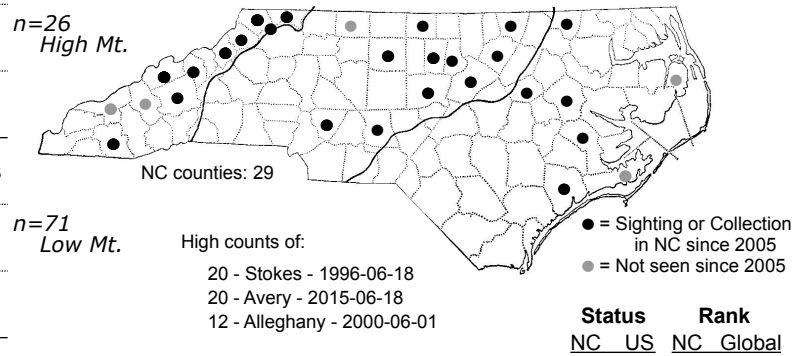
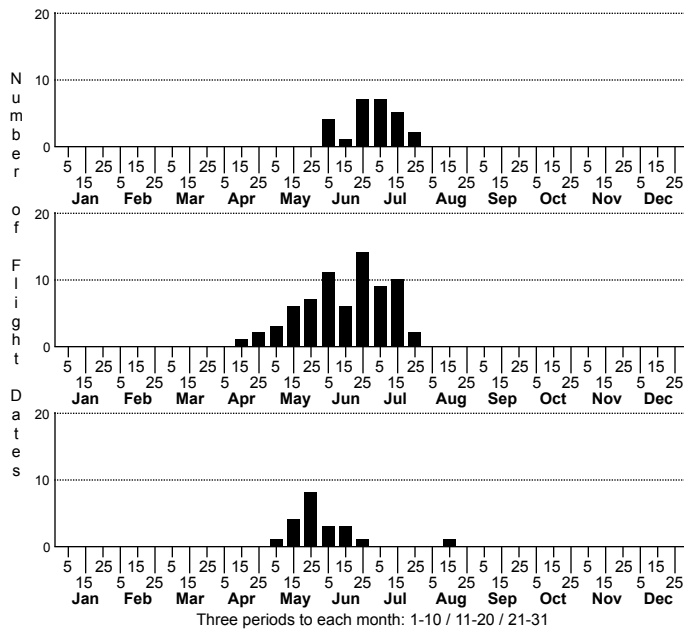


Maliattha synochitis Black-dotted Maliattha

FOOD: Larvae feed on grasses (Wagner et al., 2011). Robinson et al. (2010) also include sedges (*Carex*) and knotweeds (*Polygonum*).
