



Eublemma recta Straight-lined Seed Moth

DISTRIBUTION: The species has only been recorded in Cartaret County on the coast, apparently as an uncommon stray in North Carolina.

HABITAT:

FOOD: Reported hosts include morning-glory (*Ipomoea*), including Sweet Potato (*I. batatas*), as well as bindweed (*Convolvulus*) (Covell, 1984; Heppner, 2007).

STATE PROTECTION: Has no legal protection, although permits are required to collect it on state parks and other public lands.

COMMENTS: This species is probably a stray in North Carolina up from Florida.
