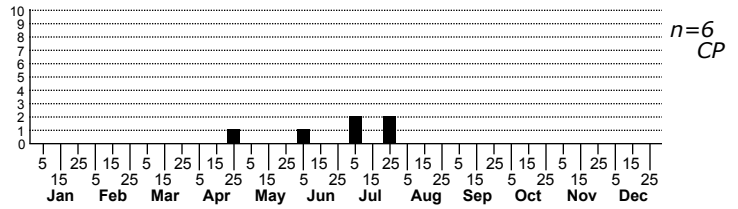
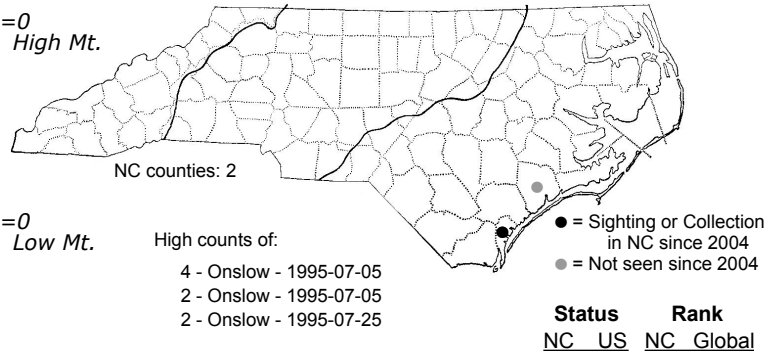
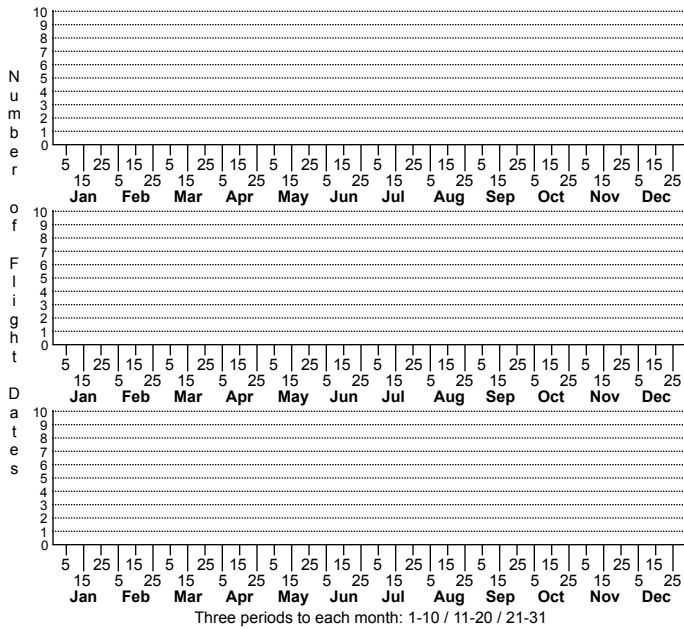


Tarache terminimaculata Curve-lined Bird-dropping Moth

FOOD: D.F. Schweitzer has found larvae on Seashore Mallow (*Kosteletzkya pentacarpos*) (Wagner et al., 2011). Other mallows might also be used but records from *Tilia* seem unlikely given the strongly coastal distribution of this species
