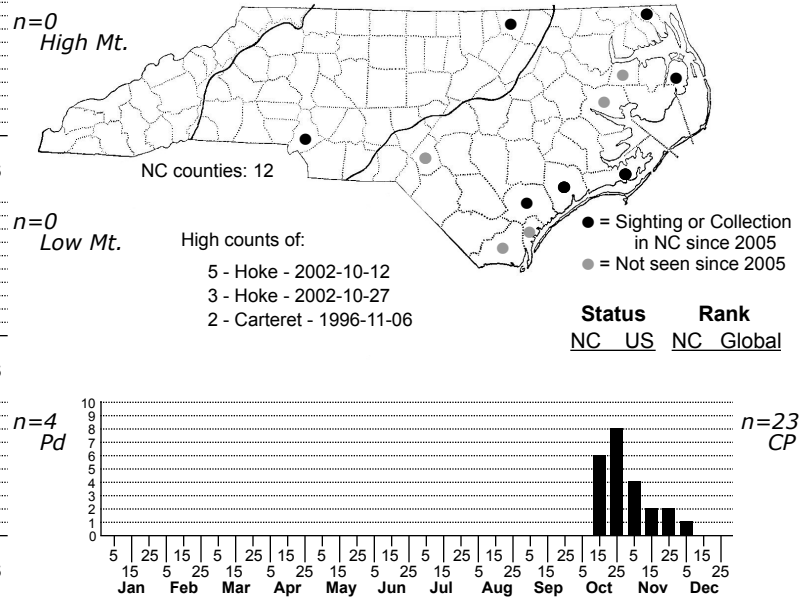
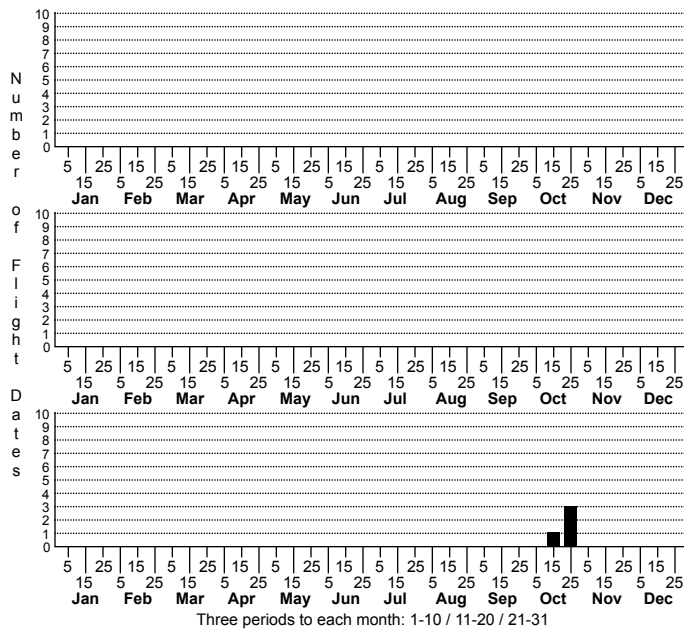

HABITAT: Our records come mainly from open habitats, including marsh edges and wet grasslands on the barrier islands, pond and lake shorelines, and wet pine savannas.

FOOD: Larvae feed on tall grasses, including plume grasses (*Erianthus*), canary-grasses (*Phalaris*), and Corn (*Zea mays*) (Robinson et al., 2010).
