




Protapamea danieli Daniel's Cane Cutworm

HABITAT: Our records come from cane-containing bottomland habitats in all regions of the state

FOOD: Larvae are borers in cane (<i>Arundinaria</i>) (Quinter, in Mikkola et al., 2009). Our records suggest that both Giant Cane (<i>A. gigantea</i>) and Switch Cane (<i>A. tecta</i>) are used.
