
Phlogophora iris Olive Angle Shades

HABITAT: Wagner et al. (2011) list woodlands and forests as habitat used by this species. Our records come almost entirely from cove forests and high elevation forests in the Mountains.

FOOD: Larvae are widely polyphagous, feeding on a large number of forbs, shrubs, and low trees. Wagner et al. (2011) specifically list alder (<i>Alnus</i>), Shrubby St. John's-wort (<i>Hypericum prolificum</i>), blackberry (<i>Rubus</i>), and ironweed (<i>Vernonia</i>).
