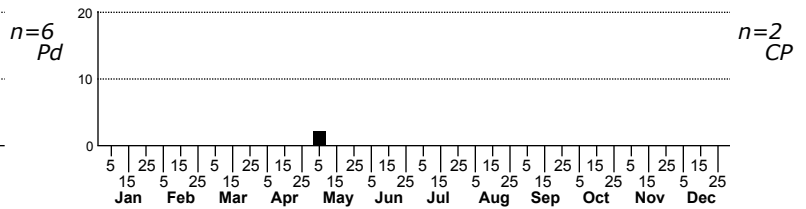
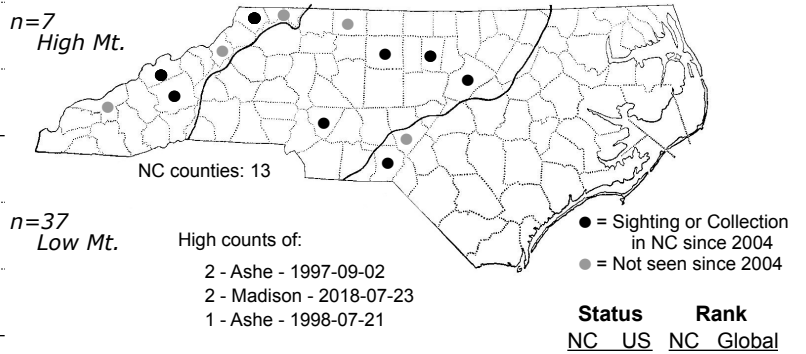
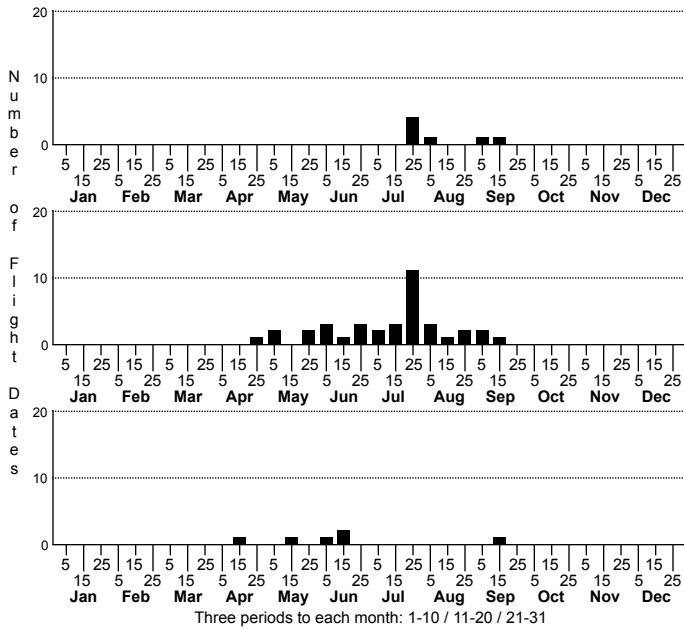


Perigea xanthioides Red Groundling Moth
