
Lithophane grotei Grote's Pinion

HABITAT: Our records all come from wet-to-mesic stands of hardwoods, from northern hardwoods on the summits of our highest mountains to non-riverine wet hardwoods in the Outer Coastal Plain

FOOD: Larvae are polyphagous on a wide range of hardwood trees, including oaks (<i>Quercus</i>), Red Maple (<i>Acer rubrum</i>), aspen (<i>Populus</i>), Yellow Buckeye (<i>Aesculus flava</i>), apple (<i>Malus</i>), birch (<i>Betula</i>), and cherry (<i>Prunus</i>) (Wagner et al., 2011).
