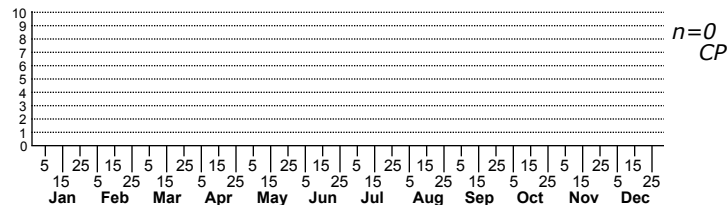
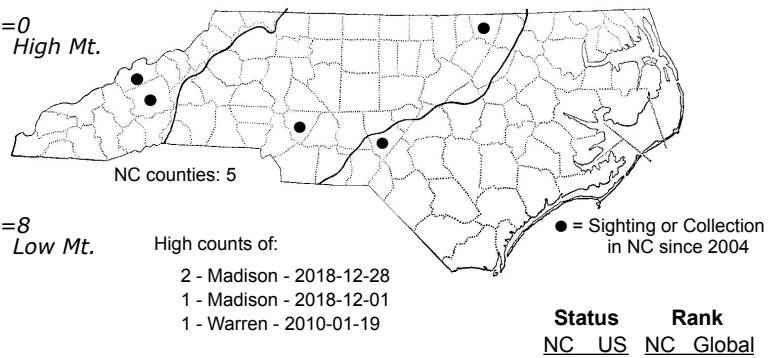
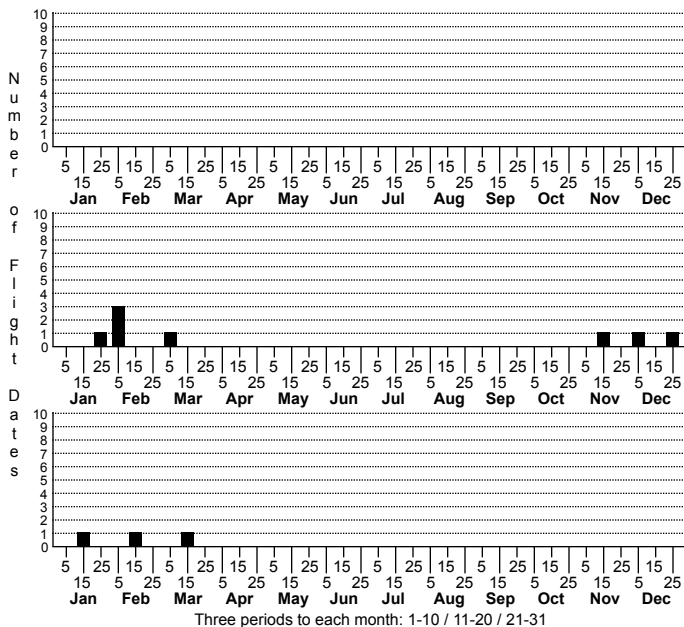


*Lithophane unimoda* Dowdy Pinion
