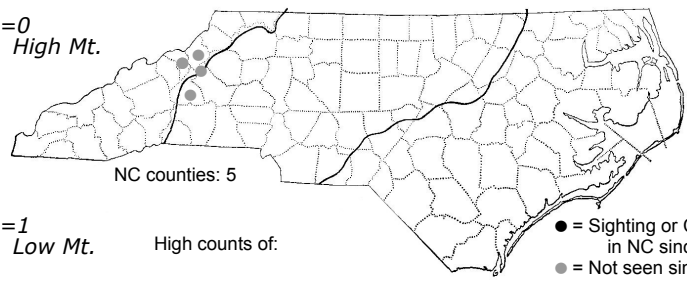
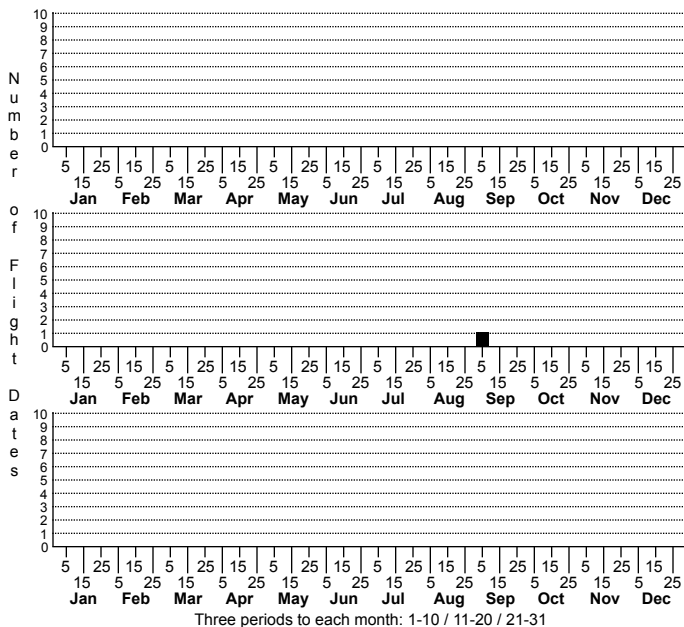
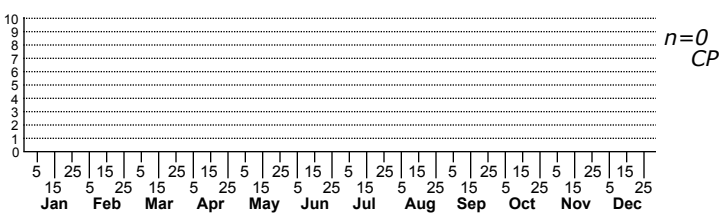

DISTRIBUTION: This species is restricted to a fairly narrow band located on the north side of the Nolichucky River, extending from the Blue Ridge Escarpment to close to the edge of the Ridge and Valley Province in Tennessee (Shelley and Whitehead, 1986)
