

A BIRD Checklist for Mount Mitchell State Park 104 taxa

Of the 473 species known from North Carolina, 104 have been recorded at the state park. Of these, 8 species are known to nest within the park. 24 are suspected of nesting. We would appreciate any report of sightings that increase our knowledge of the park's bird life.

BIRD CHECKLIST Mount Mitchell State Park



Seasons:

Spring - March to May
Summer - June to August
Fall -September to November
Winter - December to February

A - Abundant, always present in large numbers.
C - Common, almost always present in good numbers in proper habitat.
F - Fairly common, usually present and seen most days in proper habitat.
U - Uncommon, usually present, but not seen most days.
O - Occasional, often present, but not seen most weeks or only in limited area.
R - Rare, not seen most years, or seen only in very low numbers in limited area.
V - Very Rare, usually not present, seen once every five or more years.
I - Irregular, highly variable from year to year.
X - Accidental, not to be expected.
E - Escaped from captivity.
* - Known to breed.
~ - Suspected of breeding.
