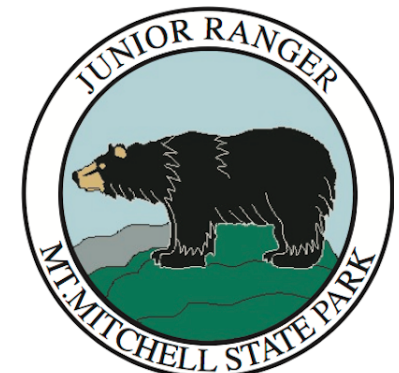
Spring - March to May
