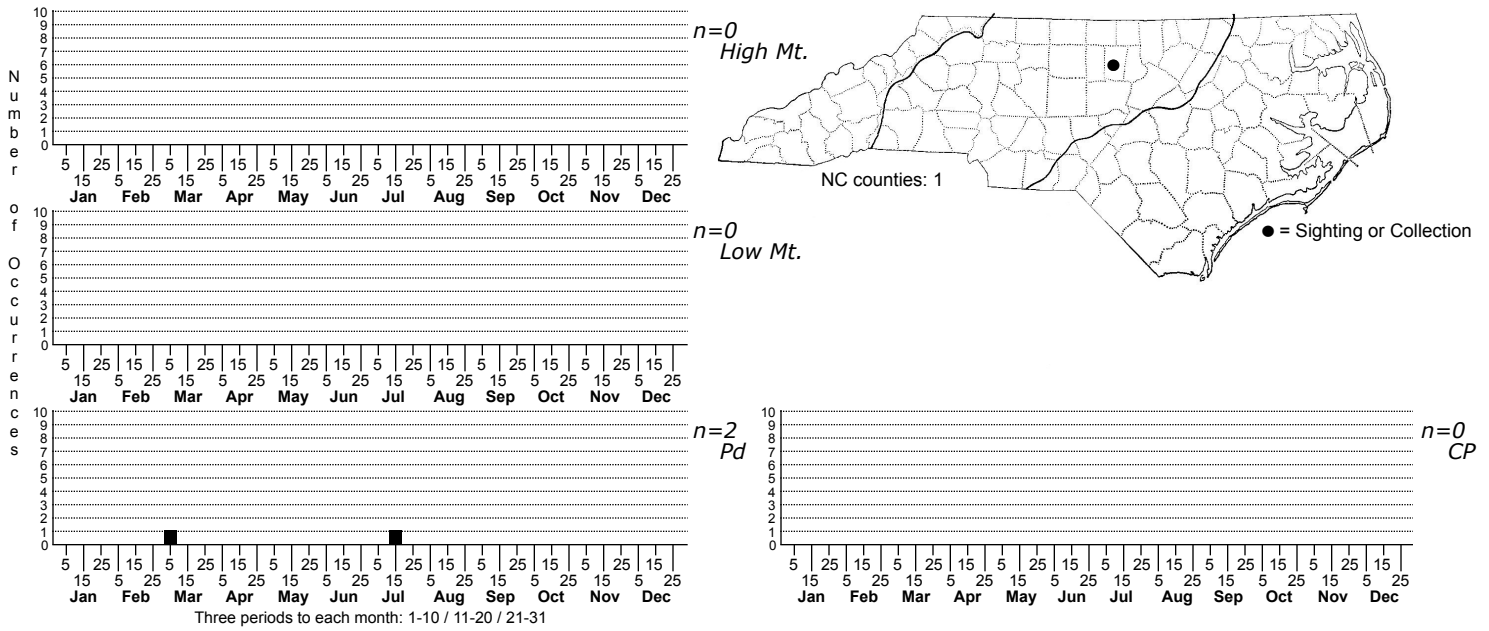

FAMILY: Echiniscidae

TAXONOMIC COMMENTS: Transferred from *Echiniscus* by Gasiorek et al. 2022.

SPECIES COMMENTS: Terrestrial. So far reported only from SC and NC from campuses of USC and UNC, thereby displaying clear preference for Atlantic Coast Conference.

ID COMMENTS: An *Echiniscus* of the *bigranulatus* group, dorsal plates with pores and true granulation, no appendages other than head appendages and lateral cirri A, weak development of dentate collars on the fourth pair of legs, and no basal spurs on any claws. -Meyer et al. 2017

HABITAT: Found on lichen and mosses on trees in urban settings.

OBSERVATION METHODS: PC, DIC and epifluorescence microscopy.
